How to submit a review

Reviewers should in the first instance email Foster Gondwe (Book Reviews Editor) via fgondwe@unima.ac.mw with an expression of interest. This should include a brief biographical description indicating your suitability as a reviewer and a list of the titles you would be willing to review.

Reviews are commissioned on a first-come, first served basis for qualified reviewers, and are due on 31 March 2024. The final collection of reviews will be published in July 2024.

Reviews should be around 1500-2000 words long and should focus on the relevance of the volume for educational technologists, instructional designers, and educators working in higher education institutions.
